A trip to MP is hard to contain within a limited number of days. The heart of India has so much to offer and is so diverse that we picked up the best of every city and curated that for you. We have diverse heritage from the Nawabi architecture of Bhopal to the exquisite Hindu and Jain temples of Khajuraho and Orchha and the Buddhist Stupa of Sanchi. Madhya Pradesh houses 9 national parks and 9 rivers and their numerous tributaries flow through it. The birthplace of the mighty Narmada, and the background to history and mythology, Madhya Pradesh is like a fascinating Pandora's box that has been lying hidden in plain sight. That Bhopal was ruled mostly by female rulers, and is referred to as Begum's Bhopal, adds another layer to F5 Escapes' tryst with the large-hearted state.

Day 1 - Reach Indore and proceed to Bhopal. Evening at Lakes

Day 2 - Explore Bhopal's heritage and museums

Day 3 - Sanchi. Khajuraho Light and Sound show.

Day 4 - Khajuraho temple tour. Evening Safari at Panna National Park.

Day 5 - Walk with Pardhis. Pandav Falls. Raneh Falls.

Day 6 - Orchha

Day 7 - Jhansi. Bhopal.

Day 1 - 21 Dec

Arrive in Indore and after a quick lunch proceed to Bhopal. Spend the evening at the Upper Lake. Drive or walk around the VIP road, which is the smaller version of the Marine Drive. Overnight at Bhopal.

Day 2 - 22nd Dec

We take a guided heritage walk through the old Bhopal city and understand the history and architecture. Bhopal was ruled solely by women for over 100 years between 1819 and 1926. The rule of Begums gave the city its waterworks, railways, a postal system and a municipality constituted in 1907.

After lunch visit the Tribal Museum and the Manav Sanghralaya. Overnight at Bhopal.

Day 3 - 23rd Dec

Today we start early as it is a long drive. Visit the Buddhist Stupa and complex at Sanchi on the way. We proceed to Khajuraho and attend the light and sound show at the temple complex. Overnight at Khajuraho.

Day 4 - 24th Dec

After breakfast, we visit the Khajuraho Temple complex and take a guided tour. The Khajuraho temples feature a variety of art work, of which 10% is sexual or erotic art outside and inside the temples; although they are the most famous. After lunch, proceed to Panna National Park and check in. Go for an evening safari. Overnight at Panna.

Day 5 - 25th Dec

After breakfast we go for a jungle walk with the Pardhis. Pardhis are a nomadic community that since the time of the Mughal emperors, have been hired to help in shikar (hunting). However, due to the combined efforts of the Forest Department and NGO's, a large part of the population has given up hunting. Thus, 'Walk with the Pardhis', an initiative not only encourages this reformation, but also aims at providing an alternative source of livelihood for the community.

After lunch with the community, visit some of the beautiful waterfalls and caves of the area. The Pandav caves are steeped in the mythology while the Raneh falls are formed as the Ken cuts deep canyons in granite rocks of different hues.

Proceed to Orchha by late evening. Overnight at Orchha.

Day 6 - 26th Dec

Explore Orchha, an ancient town and the erstwhile capital of Bundelkhand. We visit the famous Raja Ram temple early morning where the state gives a gun salute to the deity after every arti. Go for the water activities like kayaking and rafting on the Betwa river. Shop for the beautiful and Bollywood-famous Chanderi saris, silver jewellery and the Dhokra brass artefacts. Attend the light and sound show to understand the history of the region and sit by the Betwa river. Overnight at Orchha.

Day 7 - 27th Dec

After an early breakfast, leave for Bhopal. But first we visit Jhansi to explore the Rani Mahal museum. Although technically Uttar Pradesh, Jhansi is just 20 kms from Orchha, and was part of the Bundelkhand state as well. Jhansi is important for its legacy of Rani Lakshmibai. The world

needs strong women. This will be a long travel day. Reach Bhopal late evening. Overnight at Bhopal.

Day 8 - 28th Dec

After breakfast, we visit the famous rock shelters of Bhimbetka. The Bhimbetka rock shelters are an archaeological site of the Paleolithic, exhibiting the earliest traces of human life on the Indian Subcontinent, and thus the beginning of the Indian Stone Age. Enroute visit the Bhojeshwar temple. AFter lunch we leave for Indore. In the evening, visit the famous food street of Saraffa. Overnight at Indore.

Day 9 - 29th Dec

After breakfast, check out and catch your respective flights back home. The images and stories are going to be with you forever.
