

ROAD TRIP IN

BHOPAL- BHIMBETKA- AMARGARH- TAWA- MADAI- PACHMARHI

On the road: A getaway or an escape whatever you call it, road trips do come with a lot of fun and take you away from that boring routine life of yours. You get to explore more and experience more. This is the magic you can actually come closer to experiencing if exploring Bhopal and beyond is in your wish list. Just roll down the window of your vehicle, play some light music if you wish to and enjoy the beautiful scenery while on the go from Bhopal to Bhimbetka.

Start- from Bhopal

The city of lakes, as it is popularly called, Bhopal is surrounded with picturesque landscapes. The city is blessed with abundant natural beauty & captures a piece of every traveller's heart. Bhopal remains vibrant with several cool hangout joints to chill with your family or friends whereas Boat club being one of the most visited attractions here allows you to enjoy the beauty of the lake by a boat ride. Don't forget to take a cruise ride which allows you to enjoy the scenic surroundings with some sumptuous snacks and music on the go. Start your sight seeing early to explore more.

1st stop- Bhimbetka

The road trip from Bhopal to Bhimbetka is approx 45kms. The caves are a UNESCO World Heritage Site and an ideal hangout place for every adventure lover, historian, and nature lover. According to the legend the word Bhimbetka is derived from 'Bhimbaithka', meaning the seating place of Bhima, the strongest of the five Pandava brothers from the epic Mahabharata.

2nd stop- Amargarh waterfalls

Located around 60 km southeast of the city of Bhopal and in the midst of the Ratapani Wildlife Sanctuary, this place can be reached by taking a road transport to the nearest village of Khatpura. From here, you can easily walk to the waterfall, which is about a couple of hours away. Include Amargarh waterfalls in your bucket list for destinations to visit during monsoon.

3rd stop- Tawa

From Amargarh waterfalls, Tawa Dam is approx 80 kms. It is set amidst lush greenery, and offers much scope for adventure. Sunsets viewed from the dam are especially enchanting. Even more enchanting is the lake cruise, which takes you on a serene hour-long ride along the dreamy little islands dotting the reservoir and the panoramic hills of the Satpura to Churna. Here you can indulge in a jungle safari too at the Satpura Tiger Reserve.

4th stop- Madai

Madhai is located at the entrance of the most exquisite and beautiful forests in India - Satpura. This point of interest attracts tourists for its absolute tranquillity and the air of mystique. It also delights you with its rich wildlife, sprawling meadows, unending backwaters and spell-binding views that leave you awestruck and get you to be completely in sync with the magic of nature.

5th stop- Pachmarhi

When it comes to planning a road trip in Madhya Pradesh, Pachmarhi is one of the most opted destinations to explore. With scenic waterfalls and several picturesque locations, queen of Satpura is the most happening picnic spot too. It's lush green valleys leave you awestruck and if you plan a trip to Pachmarhi especially during monsoon then you will instantly fall in love with every bit of this destination.
